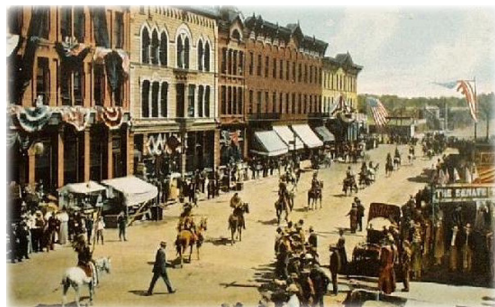
The Hynds
